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### Aims & Objectives of Curriculum

#### English

- To guide a child to learn English by introducing the letter and easy words in lower classes and focusing on development of effective communication using listening, speaking, reading and writing skill in higher classes.
- To help them develop an elegant cursive writing.
- To help learners read and understand simple words, phrases, sentences, paragraphs, recite rhymes and poems.

- To acquire knowledge, conceptual understanding and skills to solve problem and make decision.
- To help them learn scientific reasoning.

#### Social Studies

- To garner and understanding of functionality of the world, their natural surroundings and assist the child to explore their social and cultural environment.
- To make them law abiding adults.
- To foster the child interest in everything that is affecting the community.

#### Value Education

- To assist the child to become an adult of strong ethical ground and personality.
- Teach the ideas of integrity, cohesiveness, conformity, cohesion, virtue, gratitude and equality.
- To inculcate good habits and basic manners in child.

- To foster creative development in a child.
- To allow kids to enjoy the autonomy and take initiative in making something new and gain confidence in their work.
- To encourage creative expression of the child by stimulating imagination.

### Computer

- To develop a working knowledge of computer technology, learn the facts and information about computers as well as the software used to make work easier.
- To guide students to learn MS- office for writing projects, making presentation, make simple computations using Word, Excel and PowerPoint.
- To develop the ability to read and store a large amount of data and knowledge for data analysis.
